




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GALICIAN CULTURAL POLICIES: HISTORICAL BACKGROUND (1981-PRESENT)

7 mid-term cities (more of them not governed historically by PP too as Vigo, Pontevedra, A Coruña and Lugo) and other little local councils (less than 50k inhabitants)

The cultural society network of cultural associations, foundations, professional associations and other associative ones were a important stakeholder historically
